Dave's House provides hope, home and health for individuals with serious mental illness (SMI) and co-occurring disabilities which include¹:

- schizophrenia
- schizoaffective disorder
- psychotic disorders
- major depressive disorders
- bipolar disorders
- borderline personality disorder
- anxiety disorders
- eating disorders
- obsessive compulsive disorder
- posttraumatic stress disorder
- disruptive behavior disorders
- delusional disorder

Our Residents: Changing Lives

The people Dave's House serves live with serious mental illness (SMI) and co-occurring disabilities. As a result of a health crisis, they have found themselves in a place with no housing, mental health care or financial support systems.

Once established in permanent supportive housing, residents receive ongoing mental health and wellness support services. Their personal case manager works with them on life skills training, medication management and other assistance areas.

A stable home is the foundation they need to get on, and stay on, the road to wellness. Our residents are breaking the cycle of homelessness, incarceration and hospitalization, so that they may focus upon improving themselves, contributing to their communities, managing life obstacles and realizing their potential.

How We Develop Housing

1 | Acquisition



- Purchase/supplement rental funding
- Finding the perfect fit for our residents:
 - » Home functionality
 - » Neighborhood location and services
 - » Repairs and renovations

2 | Residents



- Identify residents through our mental health service and housing first service providers
- \$3,000 per resident move-in expenses
- Case Manager funding

3 | Move-in Prep



- Needs for establishing a permanent home
- Making required repairs and renovations
- Providing for utility deposits, transportation, etc.
- Furnishings and household supplies

4 | Management



- Program oversight
- Ongoing repairs and maintenance
- Ongoing coordination with mental health service providers

Dave's House provides affordable permanent supportive housing for individuals with serious mental illness (SMI) and co-occurring disabilities. Founded in 2009, the nonprofit develops housing models that combine a solid foundation of stable housing and managed mental care provided by mental health service partners.
